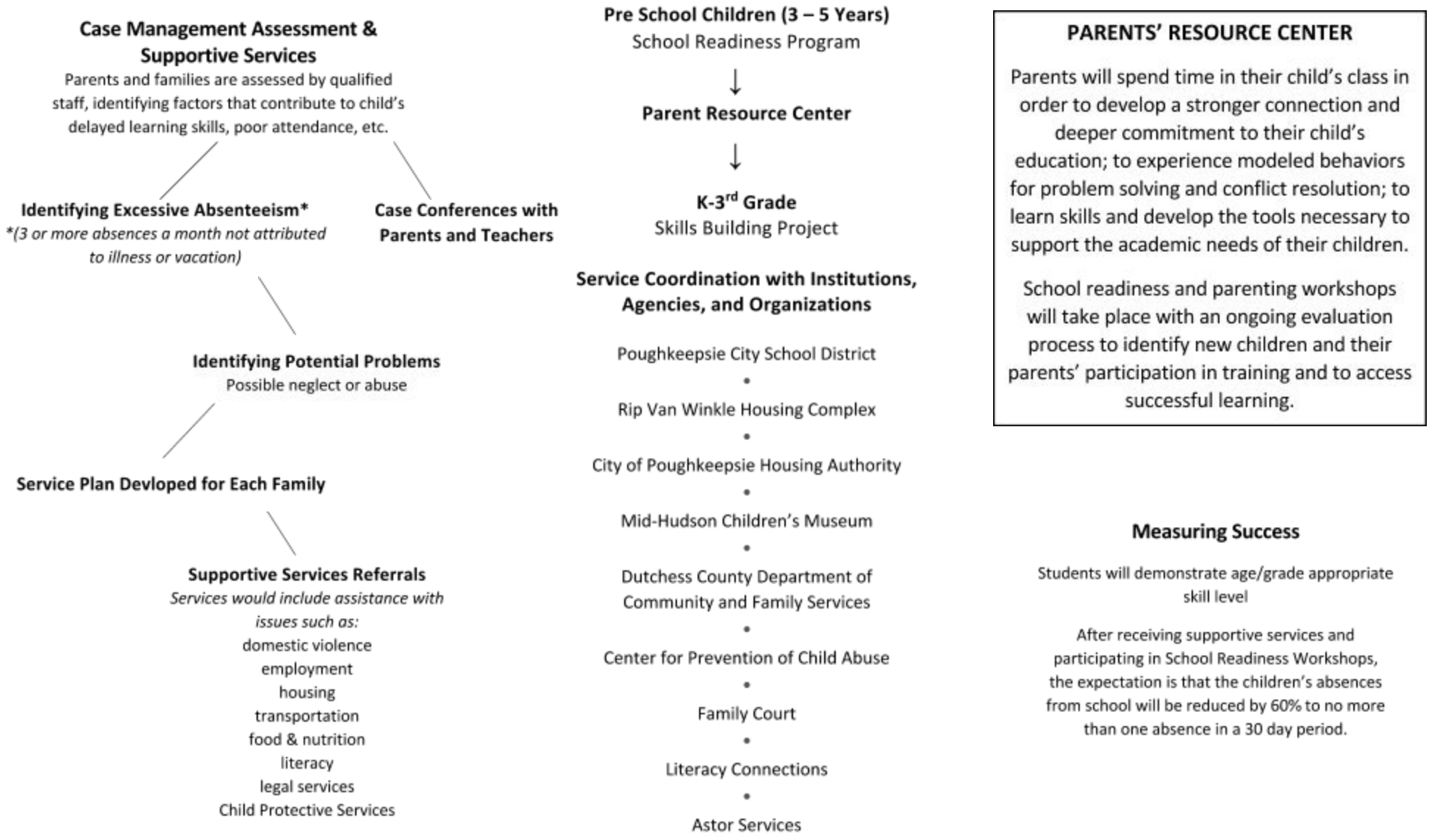

PARENTS' RESOURCE CENTER

Parents will spend time in their child's class in order to develop a stronger connection and deeper commitment to their child's education; to experience modeled behaviors for problem solving and conflict resolution; to learn skills and develop the tools necessary to support the academic needs of their children.

School readiness and parenting workshops will take place with an ongoing evaluation process to identify new children and their parents' participation in training and to access successful learning.

Measuring Success

Students will demonstrate age/grade appropriate skill level

After receiving supportive services and participating in School Readiness Workshops, the expectation is that the children's absences from school will be reduced by 60% to no more than one absence in a 30 day period.
